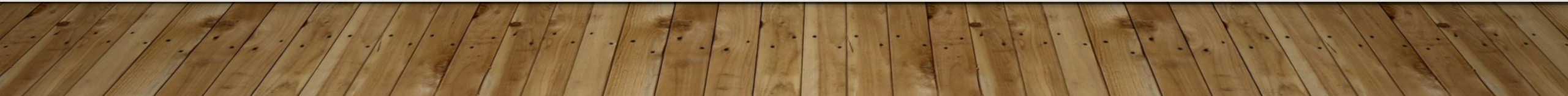

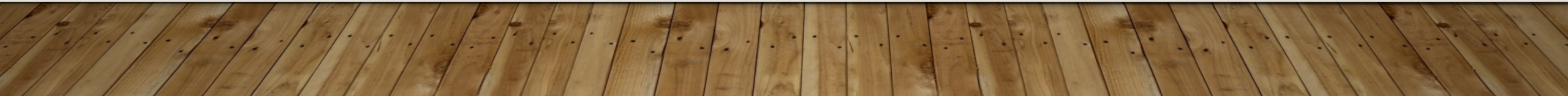
ENGLISH CLASS AT SCHOOL - PROBLEMS

- JTE has said “Just do what you want”
- There is no textbook for you to use
- JTE offers no direction or advice on what you should do
- You are not told about the topic until the day of the lesson/until you are in front of the class

ENGLISH CLASS AT SCHOOL – POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

- Ask the JTE if they do have any ideas to what they want you to do for the year
- Ask to see the CAN-DO list
- Ask what the students are doing in the JTE`s solo class
- Set a time limit on when you should have a lesson plan done/when you should know about the lesson topics
- Always have some back up activities ready to go that are multipurpose

If all that fails then time to think of fun activities that will help them in the future

★Sightseeing★

- Genbaku Dome
In 1945, Hiroshima Atomic Bomb was registered as a cultural site of World Heritage.
Sightseeing spot is Dome.
It is one of the Three Great Tents of Japan.
There is about as high as the Dome of Mum.
- Hiroshima Peace Memorial
Hiroshima Peace Memorial was designed a world Heritage site.
A building bombed at the time of World War II is just left.
It is a symbol appealing the importance of the peace.

- Festival
There is Takasaka Festival in Hiroshima.
Takasaka Festival is counted as one of three major festivals in Hiroshima.
People more than 8000 come for this festival.
It is a festival to represent summer in Hiroshima, and is loved by the city's people.

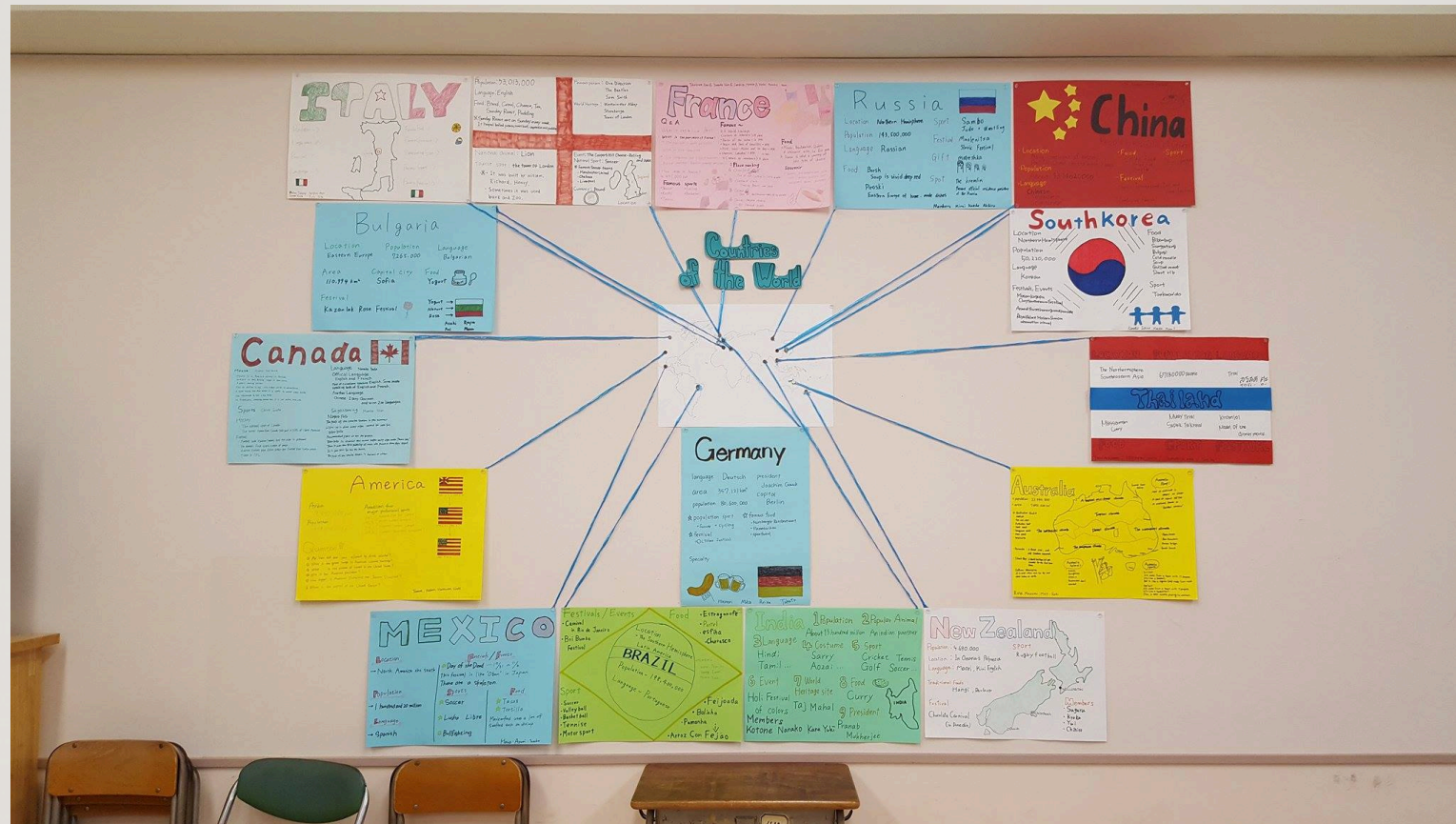

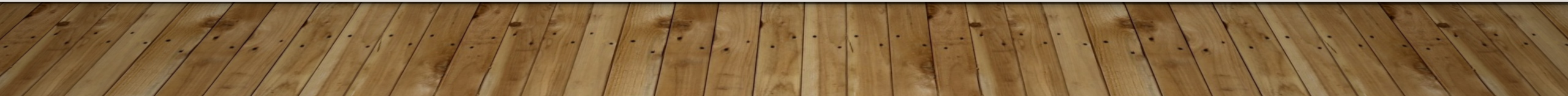


COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD

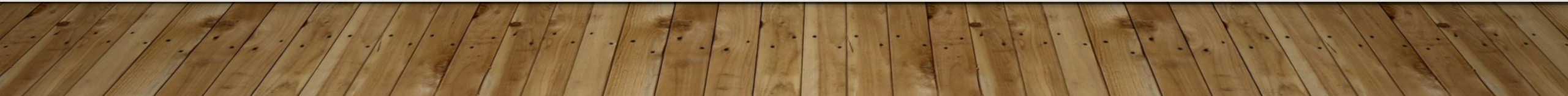
